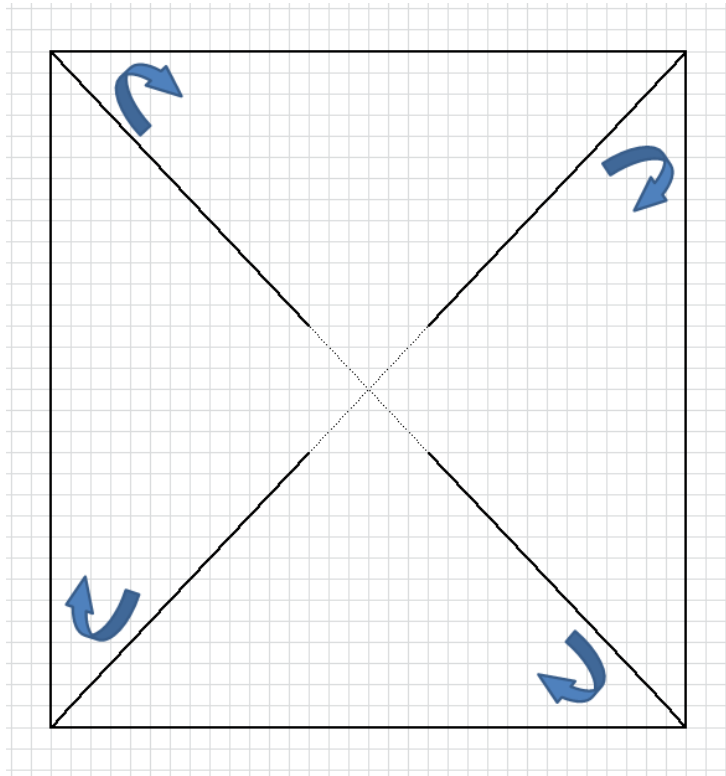


1. Cut Polka Dot Parade DSP based on the template attached.
2. Pierce the center of each piece of paper.
3. Place the vellum down with one corner pointed towards you.



<p>4. The side to the left of the cut, adhere to the center. You may want to use 2 Way Glue.</p>	
<p>5. Turn to the next point.</p>	
<p>6. The side to the left of the cut, adhere to the center.</p>	
<p>7. Repeat for the next two points.</p>	
<p>8. On the DSP, put the Polka Dot side right side up and put one of the corners towards you and repeat.</p>	

<p>9. Thread the piece of Vellum Cardstock to the Polkda Dot DSP using the brad. Don't close the brad yet.</p>	
<p>10. Thread the pinwheel brad through the coffee stirrer hole and close.</p>	
<p>11. Using Basic Black Stamp Pad, stamp a sentiment from the Tiny Tags stamp set onto a piece of Whisper White Cardstock.</p>	
<p>12. Using the Jewelry Tag Punch, punch out the sentiment.</p>	
<p>13. Pierce the end of the Jewelry Tag Punch and thread with the Linen Thread.</p>	
<p>14. Thread through the Naturals Designer Button.</p>	
<p>15. Attach the button to the pinwheel brad using Crystal Effects.</p>	



Cut on the solid lines.

You can fold it where the dotted lines are so you can cut it easier.
