1. Stamp the flower image from the **My Matryoshja** Stamp Set across the front of the card using the **Yo-Yo Yellow** Stamp Pad.













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2. On the other piece of **Whisper White Cardstock**, stamp the stacking dolls image from the **My Matryoshja** Stamp Set with the **Jet Black StazOn** Stamp Pad.

<p>5. Adhere <b>Linen Thread</b> to the back of each doll. Space dolls about 1/2" apart from each other. Then using the scrap from Step 4, adhere a small piece onto each of the dolls over the thread to keep it secure.</p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> Make sure to line the dolls to the <b>left</b> of the largest doll. <p>6. Using scraps of <b>Stampin' Dimensionals</b>, center the second largest doll on top of the largest doll and place a piece of <b>Stampin' Dimensional</b> above and below, in order to create a pocket.</p>	 <p>© Carolyn R. Stark Independent Stampin' Up Demonstrator cari_stark@yahoo.com</p>
